•Communities of Practice model of interdisciplinary collaboration-professionals from diverse disciplines, and representing diverse stakeholders, **share ideas and strategies, via emergent processes, to promote a common shared agenda** (Wenger, McDermott, & Snyder, 2002).

•As defined by the IDEA Partnership (2013), a community of practice (CoP) consists of <u>a group of professionals who care deeply about a common issue</u> <u>and decide to work together voluntarily to improve practice related to that</u> <u>issue</u>.
